I/WE hereby agree that the takaful contribution which I/WE undertake to pay to Amana Takaful PLC (the company) as tabbaru (donation) be credited in to the takaful fund for the company to manage the various schemes of takaful under the General Takaful business and pay takaful benefits to the participants as expressed in the terms and conditions of this takaful contract. If there is a surplus from the fund after payments of benefits to any participant who shall be entitled to such benefits under the said takaful contract and deducting the cost related to the fund, the same shall be distributed on pro rata among the Participants, provided always that they have not incurred any claim and/or received any benefits under the said takaful contract whilst the same is in force.

## BURGLARY TAKAFUL SUMMARY OF THE COVER AFFORDED UNDER THE CERTIFICATE

### Definition "Burglary"

The term Burglary and / or Housebreaking shall mean that following entry into the premises by forcible and violent means, or following assault or violence or threat to the Participant or to His employees or to the members of his family.

### Cover

- (a) Loss of or damage to the property covered and
- (b) damage to the buildings of the premises described in the certificate caused by theft or attempted theft following upon or followed by burglary or housebreaking accompanied by forcible and violent breaking into or out of the premises.

### Main Exclusions

- (1) Earthquake, riot, civil commotion, and war and kindred risks.
- (2) Nuclear risks.
- (3) Loss or damage by fire or explosion.
- (4) Loss or damage to
  - (a) external showcases or automatic machines or the contents thereof,
  - (b) deeds, bonds, bills of exchange, bank treasury or promissory notes, cheques, money, securities for money, stamps, collections of stamps or coins, medals, manuscripts or documents of any kind, sculptures, patterns, plans, models, designs, rare books, business books or papers, unless specifically mentioned in the certificate.
- (5) Loss or damage in which there is concerned any member of the participant's household, his business, his business staff or any person lawfully on the premises.

### Inspection

The company will usually inspect the premises and may require additional protections to improve the security of the premises. This service also benefits the participant as it may prevent a loss and the accompanying disruption of business.
